In English we will be studying 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell

Maths

In Maths we will

- Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- Compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places
- Find the effect of dividing a one- or two-digit number by 10 and 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths
- Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number
- Recognise and write decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places
