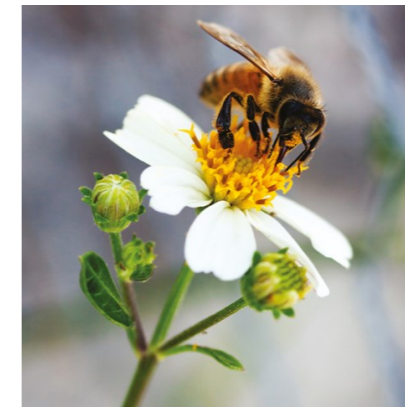


Flowers and Insects
