

A Day in the Life



This half term we will be covering the IPC unit A Day in the Life. During this unit we will be learning about jobs and uniforms. We will also be thinking about what we would like to be when we grow up and how to achieve this.

English

In English this term we will be looking at

- Fiction - Book Focus Flat Stanley including stories and recounts from different character's points of view
- Non-fiction Recounts base on the lives of different people/jobs. Use non-fiction and video clips to see the lives of others link to IPC work.
- Use an apostrophe correctly for contracted forms and the possessive.
- Use expanded noun phrases.
- Use different sentence types including question, command, statement and exclamation.
- Capital letters for names of places and people

Maths

In Maths this term we will be looking at

- Fractions
 - recognise, find, name and write fractions $1/3$, $1/4$, $2/4$ and $3/4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity
- Length and Height
 - compare and order lengths, and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$
 - choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction
 - solve problems with addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, including those involving numbers, quantities and measures
- Properties of Shapes



In Computing we will be

- Program a familiar story and make an animation of an animal
- Make a musical instruments by creating buttons and recording sounds
- Follow an algorithm to make a joke

In Art, we'll be finding out:

- How to create a portrait of ourselves to show the things that we do
- How to create an ID card for our future selves in 20 years' time

In Music, we'll be finding out:

- How to create theme music for one of our characters
- How to sing and perform the main theme music for our soap opera/show
- How to use our voices expressively and creatively in saying chants and rhymes

In International, we'll be finding out:

- How to provide a welcome party for a family from another country

In Technology, we'll be finding out:

- How to make vehicles for our street map
- How to make a uniform for one of our characters
