Maths

- add and subtract numbers mentally, including a three-digit number and ones, a three-digit number and tens, a three-digit number and hundreds
 - solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction
 - estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers
 - add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction
 - add and subtract numbers mentally, including a three-digit number and ones, a three-digit number and tens, a three-digit number and hundreds
 - write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods
 - recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables
- solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division, including positive integer scaling problems and correspondence problems in which n objects are connected to m objects
