## Awards

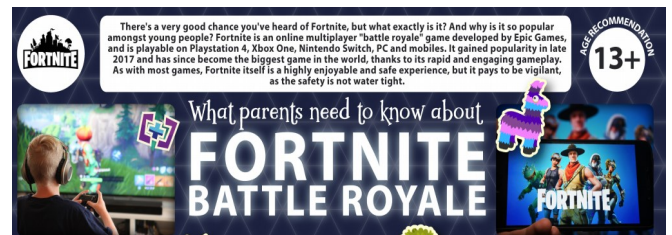
Friday's celebration assembly will restart next Friday. We are all looking forward to seeing those who receive the headteacher's awards for some outstanding learning during the week.
